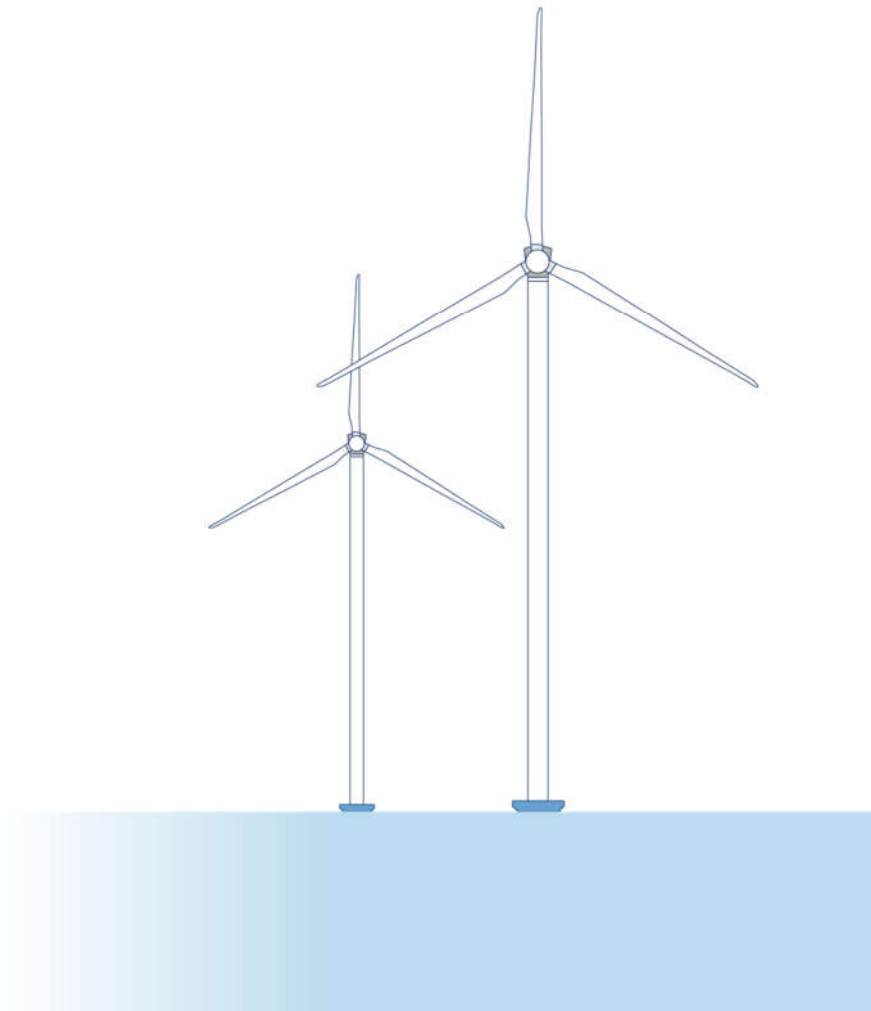




Figure 1. Research site ID1. EUNIS habitat type: Moist or wet eutrophic and mesotrophic grassland.
