**Subject: Project consisting in the construction of the offshore wind farm 'Baltica-1'**

*Dear Sir or Madam,*

I hereby kindly inform you that the environmental impact assessment procedure concerning the project consisting in the construction of the offshore wind farm 'Baltica-1', planned for implementation in the Polish Exclusive Economic Zone, has been completed. An integral part of this procedure was the transboundary environmental impact assessment carried out in accordance with Article 5 of the Espoo Convention<sup>1</sup> and Article 7 of Directive 2011/92/EU<sup>2</sup>, in which the Danish Party, the Finnish Party and the Swedish Party participated as affected Parties.

The Regional Director for Environmental Protection in Gdańsk, having taken into account the opinions received, the findings made by the authority, the results of public participation and the transboundary consultations with the affected Parties, issued on 17 October 2025 a decision on environmental conditions for the undertaking consisting in the construction of the offshore wind farm 'Baltica-1' (ref.: RDOŚ-Gd-WOO.420.59.2023.AM.42). This is a final decision within the meaning of Article 6 of the Espoo Convention. The decision is binding on the architectural and construction authority competent to issue the building permit.

With regard to the above-mentioned decision, the Regional Director for Environmental Protection issued the following rectifying and supplementing decisions:

In connection with the above, pursuant to Article 6(2) of the Espoo Convention, I hereby forward the decision on environmental conditions of 17 October 2025, ref.: RDOŚ-Gd-WOO.420.59.2023.AM.42, issued by the Regional Director for Environmental Protection in Gdańsk, together with the supplementing and rectifying decisions, in the Polish language. In addition, I enclose translations into English, Swedish, Finnish and Danish. I kindly request that information on the issued decision be made available to the public without delay, in the manner customarily adopted in your country.

I hereby inform you that the right to lodge an appeal against the decision of the authority of first instance is vested in the parties to the proceedings and in entities participating with the rights of parties.

The deadline for lodging an appeal against the decision on environmental conditions is specified in the decision. Such appeal shall be lodged within 14 days of the effective delivery of the decision in the country concerned. The deadline for lodging an appeal starts on the day following the date of service on the parties in the country concerned. **At the same time, I would like to inform you that the Polish Party considers 9 March 2026 to be the final deadline for the completion of publication by the Danish Party, the Finnish Party and the Swedish Party.**

I kindly request that the Polish Party **be informed without delay** of the date on which the forwarded decision was made available to the competent authorities and the public in the territory of the affected Party, by e-mail to: [marta.jedrzejewska@gdos.gov.pl](mailto:marta.jedrzejewska@gdos.gov.pl). Please kindly provide the **exact start and end dates of the publication of the decision**, as they are necessary for the authority conducting the proceedings.
